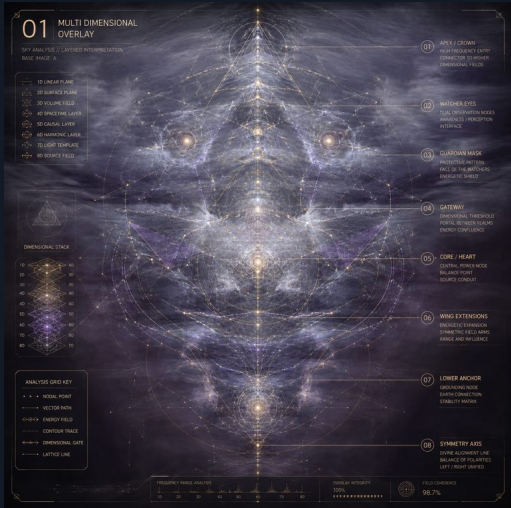

02 Arch Between Realms

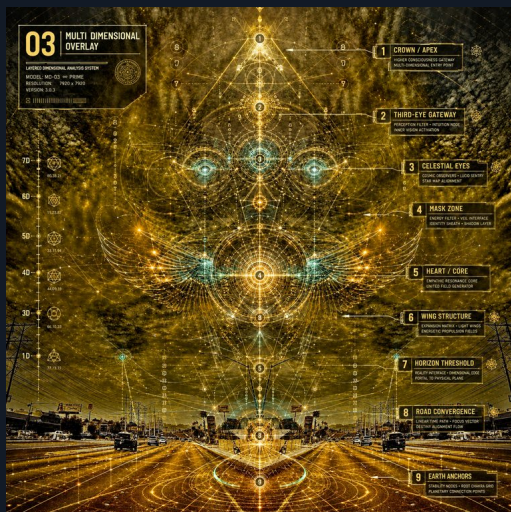


“A threshold is not proof of another world; it is the moment one way of seeing becomes another.”

Symbolic reading of mirrored imagery; not a claim of literal entities.



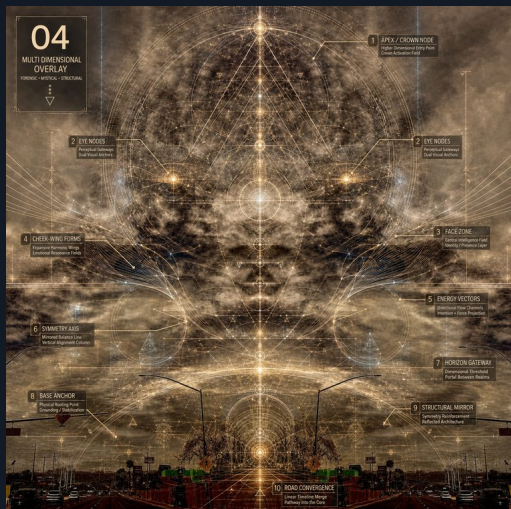
03 Nine Gates on the Golden Road
